ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- High school seniors from designated school districts in Bennington, VT and Rensselaer and Washington, NY counties, or high school seniors who are BKVR members-in-good standing attending at any high school.
- Committed to attend a fully accredited 2- or 4-year college, university, or technical school on a full-time basis, starting at the latest in the spring semester the year following your high school graduation.
- Completion of application packet.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the entire application.
- Submit an official copy of high school transcript, including senior grades, and statement of extracurricular activities.
- APPLICATION PACKET AND ALL SUPPORTING INFORMATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY APRIL 30.
- INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL **NOT** BE CONSIDERED.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Applicants will be chosen by BKVR's Scholarship Committee based on the following criteria:
 1. Academic achievement and extracurricular activities
 2. Essay
 3. Running Achievements and/or contributions to running and,
 4. School and Community Service.
- Applicants who are active members in good standing with BKVR will be given priority consideration.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND DISBURSEMENT

- To be used no later than the spring semester of the upcoming school year.
- Scholarship awards will vary up to \$1,000 and at the discretion of the BKVR
