Deadline Extension to JUNE 30!

Due to the ongoing concerns associated with the COVID-19 Coronavirus and the closure of local schools for an extended period of time, the deadline for submittal of the Jack Quinn/BKVR scholarship application has been extended until June 30. This will allow team coaches and student athletes additional time to prepare all application materials while social distancing requirements remain in place.

Each year the Batten Kill Valley Runners Club (BKVR) issues scholarships to deserving high school and college students with an interest in running. The amount of these awards varies from year to year but may range from \$250.00 to \$1,500.00 depending on the applicant's qualifications and the number of applicants. The program is open to students within southern Vermont and southern Washington County, New York, with priority given to applicants who have been members of the BKVR for at least one year. We encourage our members to apply!

Scholarship Application Requirements:

- Applications must be submitted in the spring of each year (watch the BKVR.net website for posted deadlines).
- Applicants must be interested in running and must participate actively in the sport by participating on a school track or cross-country team or by being an active member of a running organization.
- Applicants must be:
 - High School Seniors at schools located within the Batten Kill watershed who are planning to graduate in June and will be attending college in the fall; or
 - Enrolled college students.
- Applicants must complete the [application form](#) and must submit all required documents to the BKVR. Copies of the application form are also available by writing to BKVR, 823 County Route 61, Shushan, NY 12873.
- Award winners receive their scholarship grants in early January of the following year once they complete the fall semester and submit a copy of their college transcript to the BKVR showing that they successfully completed an academic semester of college.
- Applicants may reapply once they are in college.

Essays submitted by the winning applicants may be posted to the BKVR website.
